**MOTION FOR SECOND EXTENSION OF TIME TO SERVE

1. The South Carolina Court of Appeals affirmed the conviction and sentence in the above appeal.
2. On August 29, 2018, Appellant filed a Petition for Rehearing with the Court.

6. The undersigned assures the Court the Return to the Petition for Rehearing is a high priority, and she will work diligently to complete it.


7. The undersigned consulted with counsel for the Appellant, and she is authorized to advise the Court that counsel consents to the requested relief.


