<sup>1</sup> While a copy of this order was not provided with the notice of appeal, this Court has obtained a copy of this order from the public case index for Spartanburg County. I note that the public case index for Spartanburg County indicates that a motion under Rule 59, SCRPC, has been filed in this case and that no ruling has been made on that motion. Assuming this Rule 59 motion is timely, it would render this appeal premature. *See Hudson v. Hudson*, 290 S.C. 215, 349 S.E.2d 341 (1986).
