I apologize for the delay – here is the signed order on your motion to relieve counsel. I know you had some concerns about attachments to my emails – would you like me to continue to send you documents via email or send them in the regular mail (or both)?

I will keep you posted on the judge's decision regarding the mental health evaluation. I submitted your written response to be filed and sent it directly to the judge, and can send you a file-stamped copy to confirm that it's been filed. The judge informed me and the solicitor orally that he will not have a hearing – I am not sure why, but it may be because he has the opportunity to review your written opposition and the fact that there are only five business days left before trial.
