1. The Petition for Writ of Certiorari and Appendix are due to be served and filed with the Court today.



Counsel filed the Petition for Writ of Certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Michael Browning v. The State with this Court on September 21, 2018. Counsel filed the Petition for Writ of Certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Shonathan M. Jeter v. The State with this Court on September 5, 2018.


4. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay.




