




## ORDER

The State has filed a motion to strike the appendix filed by petitioner on the ground that the trial transcript contains materials that were not before the lower court in this matter and the appendix does not contain documents from the lower court that are properly a part of the record pursuant to Rule 243(f), SCACR. The State has also requested that the Court require petitioner to file an amended appendix that complies with Rule 243(f), SCACR. Petitioner has not filed a return to the motion.

The motion to strike is granted. Counsel for petitioner shall, within ten days of the date of this order, serve and file an amended appendix that complies with Rule 243(f), SCACR.
