Dear Counsel:

Upon reviewing your appellant's initial brief, the following deficiencies have been noted under the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR), and must be corrected in their entirety within ten (10) days of the date of this letter or your filing will not be accepted and the appeal will be dismissed:

- The accompanying proof of service is not in compliance with the SCACR. Your proof of service should be substantially in the format shown by Form 7 in Appendix C to part II of the SCACR. Specifically, the proof of service should reflect a description of the document being served, not a motion for extension.
- The initial brief is not accompanied by a designation of matter to be included in the record on appeal. The initial brief cannot be accepted without service of the designation of matter.
- The filing deadline for the appellant's initial brief and designation of matter has passed. It will be necessary to serve and file a motion requesting that the Court accept late service of the designation of matter. Please see Rules 208, 209 and 240, SCACR, for guidance.
