
1. The petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in this case are due to be served and filed today.
2. Counsel had an oral argument in the case of The State v. Jacob Hendricks before the Court of Appeals on November 7, 2018. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Latrone Butler v. The State with this Court on November 2,

2018. Counsel is preparing for the criminal law Comcast CLE on October 31, 2018. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of The State v. Theron Marquis Murray with the Court of Appeals on October 25, 2018. Counsel had an oral argument in the case of The State v. Jalann Williams before this Court on October 18, 2018. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of The State v. Jamil Ali with the Court of Appeals on October 17, 2018. Counsel had an oral argument in the case of The State v. Joseph Bowers before the Court of Appeals on October 10, 2018. Counsel had an oral argument in the case of The State v. Teresa Ann McCracken-Hall before the Court of Appeals on October 10, 2018. Counsel had an oral argument in the case of The State v. Ahshaad Owens before the Court of Appeals on October 9, 2018. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of The State v. Hakeem Edwin with the Court of Appeals on October 8, 2018. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Quashon Middleton v. The State with this Court on October 4, 2018. Counsel attended and presented on case law update at the Public Defender Convention in Myrtle Beach, South Carolina from September 24-26, 2018. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of The State v. Christopher Michael Jackson with the Court of Appeals on September 19, 2018. **Counsel has extensive administrative duties as the Chief Appellate Defender, including administrative and Appellate Project oversight, and training two less experienced appellate defenders.**

3. This request is made in good faith, and not for purposes of delay. Counsel intends to continue to work on the cases with more than three extensions first so that the caseload will hopefully become more manageable in the near future, and less extensions will need to be requested.




