
Dear Desiree ...

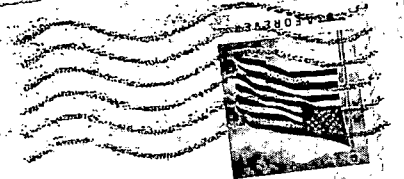

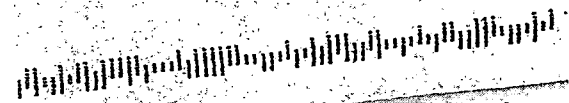
