The undersigned counsel respectfully requests a thirty day extension in which to file the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the above referenced case. In support of this motion, counsel would respectfully show the Court the following extraordinary circumstances:

1. The initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in this case are due to be served and filed today.

2. Today, November 16, 2018, counsel will file the petition for writ of certiorari and accompany appendix in Gene Tony Cooper v. The State with the Supreme Court. On November 2, 2018, counsel filed the brief of petitioner in Timothy Allen Lemacks v. The State with the Court of Appeals. On October 31, 2018, counsel filed the Anders brief of appellant and record on appeal in The State v. Tony Nevail Myers with the Court of Appeals. On October 9, 2018,


an oral argument in The State v. Felix Kotowski before the Court of Appeals. On October 4, 2018, counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of Matter in The State v. Colette Adriane Collins with the Court of Appeals. On October 1, 2018, counsel testified by telephone in the post-conviction relief case of Jonathan Brown v. The State before the circuit court. From September 24, 2018 through September 26, 2018, counsel attended the annual Public Defender Conference in Myrtle Beach. On September 21, 2018, counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in The State v. Theodore Glover with the Court of Appeals. On September 17, 2018, counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in Jerell Jackson v. The State with the Supreme Court. On August 30, 2018, counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying Appendix in Roderick Germaine Wynn v. The State with the Supreme Court. On August 24, 2018, counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in Nehemiah J. Evans v. The State with the Supreme Court. On August 20, 2018, counsel filed the Anders brief of appellant and record on appeal in The State v. Andrew Allston Kirkland with the Court of Appeals. On August 9, 2018, counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in James R. Glisson, Jr. v. The State with the Supreme Court.

3. This request is made in good faith, and not for purposes of delay. Counsel intends to continue to work on the cases with more than three extensions first so that her caseload will hopefully become more manageable in the near future, and less extensions will need to be requested.


4. As indicated by the consent below, counsel for the state graciously consents to or does not oppose this request.


