

**ASSAULT & BATTERY, 1ST DEGREE**





The defendant, James Brian Marrale Jr., did on or about May 17, 2018, in Berkeley County, South Carolina, knowingly sell, manufacture, cultivate, deliver, purchase, or bring into this State, or did provide financial assistance or otherwise aid, abet, attempt, or conspire to sell, manufacture, cultivate, deliver, purchase, or bring into this State, or was knowingly in actual or constructive possession or knowingly attempted to become in actual or constructive possession of four (4) grams or more of any morphine, opium, salt, isomer, or salt of an isomer thereof, namely Heroin, as described in Section 44-53-190 or 44-53-210, or four (4) grams or more of any mixture containing any of these. All in violation of 44-53-0370(e)(3)(a)1 of the South Carolina Code of Laws (1976) as amended.
