ORDER

This appeal is dismissed because the underlying orders are not immediately appealable. *Toler's Cove Homeowners Ass'n, Inc. v. Trident Const. Co.*, 355 S.C. 605, 610, 586 S.E.2d 581, 584 (2003) (holding an order compelling arbitration is not immediately appealable and noting a prior supreme court case held all orders relating to arbitration not mentioned section 15-48-200 of the South Carolina Code are not immediately appealable); *Lowndes Products, Inc. v. Brower*, 262 S.C. 431, 205 S.E.2d 184 (1979) (holding an order refusing to compel the taking of depositions and the production of records by a party is not directly appealable). The remittitur will be sent as provided in Rule 221, SCACR.
