

The initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the above case is due to be served and filed today, January 17, 2013. However, thorough examination of Mr. Brown's direct appeal materials revealed that an additional transcript is needed. Specifically, dialogue in the transcript of the sentence hearing on March 16, 2012, held before the Honorable Brooks P. Goldsmith, indicates that it was actually the second sentence hearing for Mr. Brown's present convictions.
