Dear Mr. Shearouse:

As a result of my telephone conversation with Ms. D. J Hopkins of the SC Supreme Court on November 16, 2018 regarding a client Mr. Gary Allen Washington, I am writing this letter to clarify my standing regarding his legal representation.

Mr. Washington selected Attorney Robinson and me as his legal. A Pro Hac Vice Application for Ms. Robinson was submitted after consultations with the client and Attorney Robinson in advance of the September hearing. However the application (Pro Hac Vice) did not receive a final decision before the September hearing. Both Amber Robinson and I consulted and consented to filing a response to the outcome of the September hearing. Ms. Robinson's Pro Hac Vice Application was also submitted again with the Motion For Relief, this time the application was promptly approved. As a result, Mr. Washington has the two attorneys he selected on the record as his legal counsel. I believe my actions affirm that I am still in the bankruptcy case.

I did however take the opportunity to explain to Mr. Washington, that I have not consented to representation in any appellate court matters. As a matter of course, all clients are informed that representation before one tribunal does not mean representation in another, including an appellant court. As I understood it, Mr. Washington began to consult with legal counsel on other appellate court matters. My conversations with Ms. Hopkins reflected that I was involved in the bankruptcy case, and that Mr. Washington would obtain other counsel for any other matter.
