Upon reviewing your appellant's final brief of the respondent/appellant, the following deficiencies have been noted under the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR), and each deficiency must be corrected within ten (10) days of the date of this letter or this cross-appeal will be dismissed:

- The color of the cover is not in compliance with Rule 267(e), SCACR. Specifically, the color of the cover is red when it should be blue.
- The content of the appellant's final brief of the respondent/appellant differs from the appellant's initial brief of the respondent/appellant. Specifically, the table of contents and table of authorities have not been included.

- The caption of the brief is incorrect, and it should match exactly with the caption given below:

Richard Beltram, Appellant/Respondent,

v.

South Carolina Department of Revenue, Respondent/Appellant.

- You must serve and file an amended appellant's final brief of the respondent/appellant in which these corrections have been made within ten (10) days of the date of this letter or this cross-appeal will be dismissed.
