
This matter comes before the Court by way of a request for leave of Court to provide an expert witness a copy of the back-up audio recordings from the jury trial in the above captioned case. This Court has previously granted the Defendant access to a copy of these recordings for review with his appellate lawyer, Tara Dawn Shurling. The Defendant subsequently requested leave to provide a copy of that recording to an expert to review for a determination concerning whether, in the opinion of the expert, there is reason to suspect the back-up audio recordings have been tampered with in any way.

The Defendant, acting through undersigned counsel, has asked for leave of court to provide his expert witness a copy of the back-up audio recordings from his trial. He requests forty-five (45) days to have these recordings reviewed, and to determine what if any further action is necessary regarding the trial transcript provided to him in his case. On the facts of this case, this Court finds Defendant's request to be reasonable. Accordingly, Counsel for Defendant is hereby authorized to provide Zac Giammarusco a copy of the audio back-up recordings from Defendant's jury trial held on May 15-17, 2017 before this Court. Counsel is given forty-five



(45) days to consult with Zac Giammarrusco to determine what if any further action is warranted concerning Defendant's challenge to the transcript of that proceeding provided to him by the Court Reporter in this case, Kay H. Richardson. Barring further action by Defendant, this matter shall be returned to the jurisdiction of the South Carolina Court of Appeals sixty (60) days from the date of this Order.
