Dear Ms. Aldaqqaq:

Upon reviewing your appellant's initial brief, the following deficiencies have been noted under the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR), and each deficiency must be corrected within ten (10) days of the date of this letter:

- The initial brief does not contain a table of contents with page references as required by Rule 208(b)(1)(A), SCACR.
- The document is improperly paginated. Specifically, you must number each page of your brief, starting with the table of contents page.
- The caption/title does not comply with Rule 267(a), SCACR. Specifically, the caption must match exactly with the one given below:

Cynthia G. Aldaqqaq, Appellant,

v.

South Carolina Department of Employment and Workforce & IQOR
Holdings US, LLC, Respondents.

- A proof of service has not been provided. You must serve and file a proof of service substantially in the format shown by Form 7 in Appendix C to part II of the SCACR.
- The document has not been signed as required by Rule 267(b), SCACR.
- The document must be double spaced as required by Rule 267(c), SCACR.
- You must serve and file an amended appellant's initial brief in which these corrections have been made within ten (10) days from the date of this letter.
