

I have recently spoke to a lawyer at Columbia Supreme Court, and he suggested I write you in reference to the case and give you all the facts.

Fact-- My hearing at the Ft. Mill court with Judge Wood on Dec 11 2017.
He told me I would receive his judgement via the mail.

Fact-- On January 08 2018 I received the judgement via ordinary mail and he found for the defendant.

Since he gave no reason for the decision, I queried what I could do, and was told I could appeal to your court.

Fact-- I filed the appeal which was dated January 31 2018,

Fact-- I was told the appeal was for May 17.

Fact-- On May 17 you stated my appeal was denied due to the fact I had not filed within the 30 days by law.

Fact-- The Ft Mill court had advised you that the judgement was mailed on Dec 15 2017. and rule 8, states the date that a judgement is mailed it is the same date it is delivered.

Fact-- the US post office states, there is no same day delivery of ordinary mail.

Fact - for this reason the ordinary mail could not have been received by me on Dec 15.

Fact-- Ft Mill has no evidence that the mail was ever forwarded or a date thereon.

Fact-- The only record that it was mailed, was that I received it on January 08 1918.

Your honor, you can see my predicament is, I have not had the appeal that I have paid \$150.00 due to an error caused by Ft Mill giving you an incorrect date of the date I received the judgement.

I am therefore appealing to you, to reset the date for my appeal.

Judge Kimball was required to deny my appeal due to the date of your judgement was listed
as Dec 11 2017 and the 30 day limit on appeal did not apply. Actually you did not give the judgement
on Dec 11 however you stated that I would receive your written judgement in the mail.

This was addressed in the Return + is highlighted in attach.
I actually received your judgement via ordinary mail in Jan 08 2018. And did file for an appeal which
was dated Jan 31. The appeal was scheduled for May 17 2018.



I actually received your judgement on January 08 via regular mail.


By making my appeal within the month of January, the 30 day law did not apply..


You no longer have a case pending in the Fort Mill Magistrate's Court.
