ORDER

This appeal was dismissed on January 22, 2016 due to Appellant's failure to file a notice of appeal in compliance with Rule 203 of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules. The remittitur was sent on February 9, 2016. Appellant has now filed a letter, which we construe as a motion to recall the remittitur.

A remittitur cannot be recalled except upon "a very strong showing . . . that remittitur was sent down through some mistake or inadvertence on the part of this Court or its officer." *State v. Keels*, 39 S.C. 553, 17 S.E. 802 (1893). Appellant has failed to make such a showing. Because Appellant failed to timely file a petition for rehearing with this Court, remittitur was properly sent, and this Court no longer has appellate jurisdiction over the case. Appellant's motion, therefore, is denied.
