The Court received your correspondence dated November 15, 2108, and construes it as your attempt to serve and file a notice of appeal.


According to Rule 203 of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules, a Notice of Appeal must include the name of the court from which the appeal is taken; the judge's name; the lower court docket number; the date of the order being appealed; the name of the appealing party; and the names, mailing addresses, and telephone numbers of all the attorneys of record and the names of the party or parties represented by each. A copy of the order being challenged on appeal, proof of service showing the notice has been timely served on all respondents, and a filing fee of \$250.00 must accompany the Notice of Appeal.

If you intend to proceed with this appeal pro se, the fact that you are not an attorney does not relieve you of the responsibility to perfect your appeal in accordance with the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules. These rules are now available on the Internet at www.sccourts.org.

Upon reviewing your correspondence dated November 15, 2018, and received in this office November 27, 2018, the following deficiencies have been noted under the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR), and all deficiencies must be corrected in their entirety within ten (10) days of the date of this letter or the appeal you are attempting to file will be dismissed:

- A proof of service has not been provided. You must serve and file a proof of service substantially in the format shown by Form 7 in Appendix C to part II of the SCACR.
- You must serve and file a notice of appeal substantially in the format shown by Form 1 in Appendix C to part II of the SCACR.
- You must provide a copy of the order(s) and/or judgment(s) challenged on appeal.
- You must provide the filing fee for the notice of appeal. The correct filing fee is \$250.00.
