TIME TO FILE RESPONSIVE BRIEF


Counsel for Respondent hereby submits a request for an enlargement of time to file Respondent's Responsive Brief until January 15, 2019. Respondent received the transcript from the court reporter via Email on September 25, 2018 and was expecting the initial brief from Appellant by October 26, 2018. 

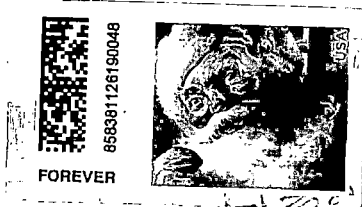
