Dear Mr. Shearouse:

I received the Court's Dismissal of the Writ as having been improvidently granted and the Remittitur by mail Monday, November 26<sup>th</sup> when I returned from Thanksgiving.

In deciding whether or not anything can be done or if there are any available remedies, I have re-read the Rules and have had discussions with several others in reference to this decision. According to the Rules, a Motion for Rehearing can be filed in every situation except where the Court has denied a Petition for a Writ of Certiorari wherein there is no Petition for Rehearing. The Remittitur shall be sent 15 days after a decision by the Court unless otherwise ordered by the Court.

In my discussions, it is my understanding there is a case on point that the Court will not allow a Petition for Rehearing to a Dismissal of a Writ as having been Improvidently Granted. If that is in fact the case, I do not want to waste my client's time or that of the Courts by filing a Motion or Petition for Rehearing that will be summarily rejected upon receipt. I would request a simple confirmation as to whether a dismissal of a Writ is treated the same as a denial of a Writ under the Rules.

By copy of this letter, I am notifying all counsel of Record of this communication and request as to whether or not a Petition for Rehearing will be considered by the Court in this situation.



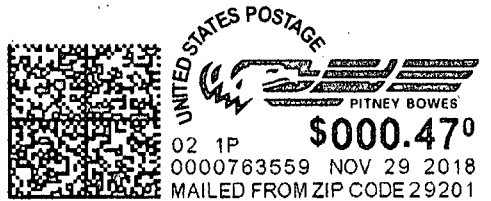
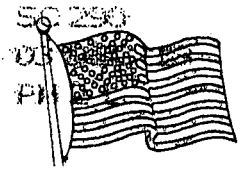
