Dear Ms. Kitchings:

I represent Ronald Hakeem Mack, the respondent in the above-referenced appeal. After a review of the briefs filed in the case, I am submitting supplemental authority pursuant to Rule 208(b)(7), SCACR. In its reply brief, the state argued Respondent's argument to dismiss the state's appeal as interlocutory was not properly before this Court. See Reply Brief of Appellant p. 1, n. 1. Specifically, the state argued "Respondent did not seek rehearing of the denial of the previous motion" to dismiss as interlocutory. The state cited Rule 240(j), SCACR, for the proposition that "[a]ny review of an order issued by an individual judge [] shall be by petition for rehearing." As a supplemental citation, Respondent directs this Court's attention to Rule 240(i), SCACR, which provides: "The court will not entertain petitions for rehearing on a motion or petition unless the action of the court on the motion or petition has the effect of dismissing or finally deciding a party's appeal."
