The Respondents file this motion for extension of time and motion to supplement the Record on Appeal under the authority of Rules 240 and 212(b). Rule 240, SCACR; Rule 212(b), SCACR.


Mr. Alston has not complied with Rule 210, and his failure to do so prohibits Respondents from filing their final brief on time. Mr. Alston served a copy of his amended Record on Appeal on November 19, 2018. But he included only three items from Respondents' Designation of



Matter; specifically, items one, two, and four. All other items were missing, including the July hearing transcript. Consequently, Respondents cannot comply with Rue 211(b)(1) regarding references to the Record on Appeal. Rule 211(b)(1), SCACR (“The references in the initial brief shall be revised [in the final brief] to indicate where the material appears in the Record on Appeal.”).

Given the inability to comply with Rule 211(b)(1), Respondents respectfully ask the court to grant their motions. Regarding the motion for an extension of time, Respondents’ request an additional 20 days from the date the Court grants their motion to supplement the Record on Appeal.






