**Dr. Assa'ad-Faltas' SECOND NECESSARY SUPPLEMENT TO Her Motion  
 to Relieve Appellate Defense and for Related Relief.**

SCIENCE is not only test tubes, DNA, and microscopes. The essence of science is analysis of *quantified* observations, not arm-chair speculation. As such, Science is a friend of, not an enemy to, the law. The proud-as-the-Pyramids Dr. Assa'ad-Faltas reacted to this Court's writing in June 2017 (in ridicule of her) that she had (horror of horrors) applied for an administrative position to apply scientific methods to the judicial system, as every scientist would: "What is wrong with that?"

Just as Egypt's Moslem majority could not get Dr. Assa'ad-Faltas to relinquish her Christianity, this Court's formalism will not get Dr. Assa'ad-Faltas to relinquish her scientific approach to problems.

A preliminary analysis of all SC's Court of Appeals published PCR cases is attached in support of the position that a grant of PCR should not be appealable by the State. Analysis of this Court's published PCR cases shall, God willing, follow, as time permits. **Both are offered in the spirit of assisting this Court to achieve judicial economy while remaining faithful to the Constitution. The question asked by this analysis is: Is the risk of delay of a new trial for a PCR applicant deserving of one so substantial as to violate the Sixth Amendment right to speedy retrial if the State is allowed to continue to appeal grants of PCR? The quantified answer is: YES.**

To capture all cases, not a mere sample which may be biased, the search terms "Post-Conviction Judge" and "Post-Conviction Relief Judge" were entered in SC's JD's website's opinion search and the two lists were combined and filtered for the Court of Appeals. Of the 74 cases returned, 37 were not PCR cases. Of the remaining 37, two were excluded because one dealt, not with the PCR itself, but whether PCR applicants are immune from Rule 11; the other granted a belated appeal and affirmed.

Of the remaining 35, applicants had brought 24, the State 11. Of the latter, the grant of PCR was reversed in eight (8) cases and affirmed in three (3), *at the Court of Appeals*. Also relevant to the Sixth Amendment right to speedy retrial are the cases where the State sought *certiorari* from the Court of Appeals' reversal of PCR denials by the trial courts and this Court either Appeals' reversal of the trial court's denial of PCR. In those three types of cases, the new trial or new sentencing was delayed for years or decades and the unconstitutional sentence had been served, the applicant had died, or other circumstances made the relief meaningless, by the time the State's appeals were disposed.

The State had better results than PCR applicants before SC's Court of Appeals; *but constitutional rights are not based on the law of averages*. Also, PCRs rarely grant acquittals, only new trials or re-sentencing. *The State's appeals of PCR grants likely cost more than a new trial, even if granted in error by PCR*. Better to mount ten unnecessary new trials than to delay one necessary new trial.

Therefore, Dr. Assa'ad-Faltas asks this Court to make an earlier decision than projected by this Court's 19 October 2018 ORDER on Dr. Assa'ad-Faltas' right to advocate *pro se* as a respondent, or at the very least, to allow her to now submit her full *pro se* brief urging unappealability of grants of PCR.
