Dear Mr. Woods:

The Court is in receipt of your letter dated November 16, 2018, inquiring about the record on appeal, final briefing, and number of copies to be filed. In response to your statement that you were waiting on the respondent to file a reply brief to your amended initial brief, our records show that the Court received an amended initial reply brief of appellant on August 21, 2018, in response to the Court's July 20, 2018 order. The respondent was not directed to file an amended initial brief of respondent since it was your initial reply brief that was amended and not your initial brief of appellant. Once your amended initial reply brief was filed, the appeal was to proceed with the record on appeal and final briefing, pursuant to Rules 210 and 211 of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR).

Pursuant to the Court's November 2, 2018 order, the record on appeal was due to be served upon the respondent and the proof of service filed with the Court no later than December 3, 2018. The record on appeal is supposed to be a compilation of all the items/documents listed on the designations of matter filed by both the appellant and respondent.

Pursuant to Rules 210(b) and 211(a), SCACR, when filing the record on appeal and your final briefs with the Court, you must file one unbound copy and fourteen bound copies. The Court's letter dated November 8, 2018 provides information on what proper binding is and is not appropriate. If you wish to file fewer copies, a motion will need to be made. No matter what, you must serve a copy of the record on appeal and your final briefs upon the respondent.

As stated above, the Court's November 3, 2018 order, directed you to serve the record on appeal upon the respondent and file the proof of service with the Court no later than December 3, 2018. Within ten days of the date of this letter, you must provide the proof of service for the record on appeal.
