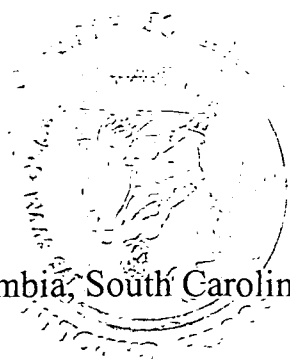

Appellant's motion to consolidate this appeal with Appellate Case No. 2016-001708 is denied. Respondents' motions to strike Appellant's initial reply brief are also denied.

Respondents' motion to correct the record on appeal is granted to the extent that Appellant shall amend the covers and captions for the record on appeal to remove the term "Special Appearance" and "Special Appearance Counsel." Counsel for the Attorney General shall be listed as set forth in the Attorney General's designation of matter. In addition, within thirty days, Appellant shall serve and file a supplemental record on appeal which includes the Attorney General's designation number 20—Letter from the Attorney General's office to Judge Early dated May 25, 2017. The motion to correct the record is otherwise denied. Respondents shall serve and file their final briefs within twenty days of service of the supplemental record.
