Dear Counsel:

It appears to the Court that you represent Ms. Castro in the civil action 2018-CP-32-01221. Ms. Castro filed a notice of appeal for this case on December 3, 2018. Pursuant to Rule 264, SCACR, the attorney of the respective party in the court below shall be deemed the attorney of the same party in the appellate court until withdrawal is approved. If you have already been relieved as counsel for the appellant in the circuit court, you will need to provide a copy of that order to the Court within ten (10) days of the date of this letter. Otherwise, you will remain counsel of record until you file a motion to be relieved as counsel, and all future filings must be submitted by you. *See Miller v. State*, S.C. 347, 347, 697 S.E.2d 527, 527 (2010) ("Since there is no right to 'hybrid representation' that is partially *pro se* and partially by counsel, substantive documents, with the exception of motions to relieve counsel, filed *pro se* by a person represented by counsel are not to be accepted unless submitted by counsel.").

Within ten (10) days of the date of this letter, you must provide proof that a copy of this appeal has been filed with the lower court clerk of court, as required by Rule 203, SCACR, as well as, proof that the transcript has been timely ordered, as required by Rule 207, SCACR, or this appeal will be dismissed.
