This matter came before the Court on May 29, 2018 to resolve numerous pending motions. Among those pending motions were three Motions for Summary Judgment filed variously by Defendants Stephen Dudek, Doreen Cross, Allison Williams, First Federal Bank, Michael Scarafile, Susan Nicholson, Carolina One Real Estate, Carrie Boyer, and the Woody Law Firm. A Hearing was set for May 29, 2018 at 10:00 AM and properly noticed to all parties including Plaintiff. Counsel for all Defendants appeared for the Hearing. Plaintiff did not appear. At 6:42 AM on May 29, 2018, Plaintiff emailed the Court and counsel stating:

All, my apologies but I;ll [sic] be unalbe [sic] to attend today's hearing. I'm on my way to the emergency room with my daughter with severe abdominal pains Sorry for the brief message but in a hurry.

Prior to the Hearing, on May 15, 2018, Plaintiff emailed Chief Deputy Clerk of Court Becky Stevens requesting that the court reschedule the Hearing because Plaintiff would "be out of town for the Memorial holiday weekend and would not be back until Wednesday." Ms. Stevens advised Plaintiff that a continuance could only be granted if all parties consented. On

May 18, 2018, eleven days prior to the Hearing, Plaintiff filed a Motion for Continuance based primarily on a planned vacation to Arlington Cemetery and a sailing trip from Beaufort, North Carolina to Hampton, Virginia.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

1. Within ten (10) days of the date of this Order, Plaintiff shall submit proof of Plaintiff's (or Plaintiff's daughter's) admittance to the Emergency Room showing, to the satisfaction of the court, the existence of such an emergency and, but for the emergency, Plaintiff would be able to attend the Hearing scheduled for 10:00 AM, May 29, 2018 at the Dorchester County Courthouse. Such proof shall consist of or include emergency room intake forms or admittance records indicating the date, time, and location of such intake or admittance. Plaintiff is permitted to redact personally identifiable information and sensitive medical information.
2. If such proof is not provided, or if the court is not satisfied with the completeness or accuracy of the information, the Defendants' dispositive motions shall be granted. All pending motions filed by Plaintiff shall be denied.
3. If such proof is provided to the satisfaction of the court, the motions currently pending before the Court will be placed on the August 6, 2018 Motions roster.
4. This matter is hereby removed from the June 25, 2018 Jury Trial Roster.
5. To the extent necessary, this matter will be placed on the September 24, 2018, Jury Trial Roster.
6. Within ten (10) days of the date of this Order, Plaintiff is hereby further ordered to provide a true and accurate address of record at which Plaintiff can and will receive personal service.

The above does not indicate and the Court does not order any change to the scheduling order in place in this matter. The Court understands that the Deposition of Plaintiff Molly Morpew was held open and continues to be open. This order does not affect the ability of Defendants to continue the deposition of Plaintiff.

Finally, this Court specifically finds that Defendant David Collins is not in default or good cause exists to set aside any such entry of default.

AND IT IS SO ORDERED.
