From the last letter i received from Edwin Martin Attorney for the Defendants, Dated June 8, 2012 I had asked to have the person at the mediation because of the lack and loss of the most important papers to show the complete cause of the accident and to support what was not sent to the MSA board (Medical Set-a-Side). The 72 pages sent to the MSA board does'nt even report all of the body parts that had to be operated on or what would be damaged for the rest of my life and just what would be the effects of these body parts for the rest of my life and the quality of what the lifewas going to be.

Since the Defendants will not accept these people being at the mediation and i'm not able to show the mediators the correct documents that are not in the medical Set-a-Side then we must go ahead with the hearing.





The letter came to me on August 18, 2012. As you could understand i am a person with no money as you can tell from the time of dates in between me being able to send the documents in to the court system. I have worked very hard to be able to try to do all of this on my own. From the first hearing of April ,2009 when the hearing was incomplete and most all of the proof of my case was not heard and the Commissioner ruled on just me being run over and all the lost evidence was not entered at this hearing and the Law Firm DID NOT enter my appeal as i told them to the very same day after the hearing took place. I have not had a true and/or a complete hearing on all the true events of the accident that took my life as far as being able to provide for my family. I my self having to try to act as an attorney and also not having the money to back me to get to have a complete hearing . I have been working on these wrong doings from may 2009 up until the present. I have been blocked to bring these document to show that all the incomplete and lost document all the way from the Highway Patrol, Doctors and the Law Firm would not put these document forth because they could not explain why these documents were and are incomplete. I have tried to obtain a law firm to take this case or to help me present all the correct papers to get me an honest trial with a jury , But Edwin Martin has been able to block these documents from being seen because in my opinion the outcome would be different. 


