Dear Mr. Shearouse:

My Petition for a Writ of Certiorari and two copies of the Appendix are due to be filed in this matter on today's date. Due to my heavy State and federal trial and appellate schedules, however, I will be unable to complete my work on these documents by that date. Additionally, I realized in my preparation of these documents that I needed to include all of the exhibits introduced during the PCR hearing within the Appendix. I received these documents earlier this week. One of the exhibits is a 140-page transcript that must be heavily redacted, and it has taken me several hours to do so. Accordingly, as I could not get the Appendix prepared in time for filing today, I am requesting a two-week extension of time in which to file these documents. There have been three prior extension requests in this matter.
