MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME
IN WHICH TO FILE THE PETITION FOR WRIT
OF CERTIORARI AND APPENDIX

Counsel filed the Petition for Writ of Certiorari with the appendix in the case of Larry James Tyler v. The State with the Court of Appeals on October 31, 2018. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of The State v. Kevin McDaniels with the Court of Appeals on October 23, 2018. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of The State v. Rusty Antron Jones with the Court of Appeals on October 17, 2018.

4. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay.


5. Counsel for the Attorney General's office has been informed of this request.




