
This matter comes before the Court on Plaintiffs' Motion for an Exception to the Physical Presence Rule at Mediation.

The Court notes that it previously held a hearing on this same issue on October 4, 2012. As a result of that hearing, the Court issued an Order granting the Plaintiff's request for an exception to the physical presence rule at mediation for represented James Brown family members and minor children.

After considering the parties' arguments as to the instant motion as well as its prior ruling after extensive briefing and oral argument by the parties, the Court hereby finds and orders as follows:

1. The Court directs the parties to proceed with and participate in good faith in the mediation scheduled for October 22, 23, or 26, 2015.
2. Plaintiffs' motion is GRANTED to the extent it seeks an exception to the physical presence rule at mediation for represented James Brown family members, provided any absent family member is represented by counsel that is physically present.
3. Plaintiffs' motion is GRANTED to the extent it seeks an exception to the physical presence rule at mediation for all of the minor children and for a jailed adult family member. The court FINDS, under these facts and circumstances, that for this mediation there is no necessity to appoint any guardians *ad litem*.

AND IT IS SO ORDERED.
