This office will not review filings for redaction or to determine if materials should be sealed.

This Court has already dismissed your notice of appeal seeking review of the dismissal of this post-conviction relief case. *Samuel v. State*, Appellate Court Case Number 2015-001301. In the current appeal, you seek review of an order dated November 14, 2018, which denied your motion for reconsideration regarding an order dated April 21, 2014. That 2014 order restricted your ability to file future post-conviction relief actions regarding your 2001 convictions and sentence for armed robbery and assault and battery of a high and aggravated nature. While you did not provide this Court with a copy of either the April 24, 2014 order or the November 14, 2018 order, this Court has obtained a copy of these orders from the circuit court.

Since it does not appear that any hearings were held in this case, we have marked our records to reflect that the petition for a writ of certiorari and appendix are to be served and filed within thirty (30) days of the date of this letter. The petition and the appendix will need to comply with the requirements of Rule 243, SCACR.
