ORDER

Petitioner has failed to provide a proof of service showing that a copy of the notice of appeal has been served on the counsel for the State as required by Rules 243(b) and 203(d)(1)(B)(i) of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR). Further, in the explanation required by Rule 243(c), SCACR, petitioner has failed to show that there is an arguable basis for asserting that the determination by the lower court was improper.¹

Accordingly, this matter is dismissed. The remittitur will be sent as provided by Rule 221(b), SCACR.
