
YOU WILL PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that Defendant by and through his undersigned counsel will move before this Honorable Court, as soon as counsel can be heard, for a NEW TRIAL pursuant to South Carolina Rule of Criminal Procedure 29, on the following grounds:

1. The Court erred in failing to present the Defendant's properly requested Voir Dire to his jury panel prior to jury selection. (Defendant's Proposed Voir Dire entered as a Court's Exhibit)
2. The Court erred in Denying Defendant's Motion to Suppress evidence of "Prior Difficulties". (Defendant filed a written motion with the Clerk of Court and the motion was entered as a Court's Exhibit)
3. The Court erred in Denying Defendant's Motion to Suppress Inadmissible Lyle Evidence.
4. The Court erred Denying Defendant's Motion to Suppress a Jail Phone Call alleged to have been made by the Defendant with adequate and legal notice as to the taping of his jail phone calls. (Defendant filed a written motion with the Clerk of Court and the motion was entered as a Court's Exhibit)
5. The Court erred in denying Defendant's Motion for Directed Verdict.
6. The jury's verdict was not supported by the evidence.
