MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME

1. The Petition for Writ of Certiorari and Appendix are due to be served and filed with the Court today.



Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari with the accompanying appendix in the case of Bradley Gerald Mullins v. The State with this Court on November 5, 2018. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of The State v. Christopher Greene, III with the Court of Appeals on October 30, 2018. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of The State v. Franklin Dell Hayes with the Court of Appeals on October 5, 2018. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of The State v. Alqi Dhimo with the Court of Appeals on October 5, 2018.


4. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay.




