1. The Petition for Writ of Certiorari and Appendix are due to be served and filed with the Court today.



Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of In the Interest of Zahi H., a Juvenile Under the Age of Seventeen with the Court of Appeals on November 16, 2018. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari with the accompanying appendix in the case of Bradley Gerald Mullins v. The State with this Court on November 5, 2018. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of The State v. Christopher Greene, III with the Court of Appeals on October 30, 2018.


4. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay.


