MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME  
IN WHICH TO FILE THE INITIAL BRIEF  
OF APPELLANT AND DESIGNATION OF MATTER

number of extensions previously granted and the order in which counsel attempts to manage his caseload, counsel hopes that no further extension requests will be required.






5. The undersigned counsel has consulted with counsel for the state, and he is authorized to advise the Court the state consents to or does not oppose the requested relief.
