Dear Mr. Lynd:

The South Carolina Court of Appeals has issued two remittiturs in the above appeal.

One of these was issued on November 28, 2018, in response to this Court's denial of a petition for a writ of certiorari to review the Court of Appeal's order dated March 22, 2018.¹ The order of March 22, 2018, dismissed all of the respondents other than the South Carolina Law Enforcement Division and Dawn Caldwell in her individual capacity.

The other remittitur, which is dated November 16, 2018, was issued regarding an order of the Court of Appeals dated August 24, 2018. This order dismissed the appeal as to the two remaining respondents (South Carolina Law Enforcement

Division and Dawn Caldwell in her individual capacity).² As a result, all portions of the above appeal have now been remitted to the circuit court.

This Court has now received various documents from you in an envelope post-marked December 26, 2018. Since the remittitur has been sent by the Court of Appeals as to all portions of the appeal, appellate jurisdiction over this case has ended. *Wise v. S.C. Dept. of Corr.*, 372 S.C. 173, 642 S.E.2d 551 (2007). Therefore, no action will be taken on any of these documents by this Court.
