MOTION TO SUSPEND BRIEFING

Pursuant to Rules 240, SCACR, the State requests for this Court to stay briefing and reverse Appellant Greene's conviction and sentence. Appellant Greene was convicted of possession of methamphetamine. On appeal, Greene challenged the search and seizure resulting in law enforcement discovering .19 grams of methamphetamine in her purse. Following a suppression motion and bench trial, she was convicted and sentenced to one year imprisonment suspended to nine months probation.
