
This responds to your letter dated December 27, 2018.

Dear Supreme court,

Here is what going on with me inside ^{SC} SUPREME COURT the South Carolina Department of Correction. Were I believe Department of Correction helping Charleston County Court system conspire to assassinate me inside here. I believe the people who was in the courtroom the day I got sentence. When I first arrive at Evan Institution in 2011 I file for my p.c.R application. Then a lot of strange things started to happen to me. One afternoon I ate something out their cafeteria and later that day I started spitting blood. I file for my indictment to work on my case to send in my post-conviction relief application. Then even more serious strange thing started to happen. I started having poor bowel movement, My weight drop rapid, I felt a hernia in one of my heart vessel and I believe I was food poison. I complain numerous time about my condition. I wrote a request to the head warden, associate warden, and head nurse about my condition. The doctor at that time he told me that ain't nothing wrong with me, that its all in my head. I couldn't get no help here but I follows proper procedure about getting medical treatment. So I started writing for help, these are the state and diplomatic official I wrote. South Carolina Department of Correction, Indigent defensive attorney, Charleston Clerk of Courts, and 3 letter to the South Carolina Supreme Court. Of me being assassinate behind these Indictment. On June 25 2012, Honorable William R Byars Jr. say he was forwarding my letters.

Then I wrote ex-president Barack Obama. The mail room at Evans said it was Barack Obama questionable material. The letter got approved it by S.C. DC Feb 27, 2013 out returned to me. Then I wrote ex attorney General Eric H Holder never heard nothing from him. I wrote Charleston Clerk of Court telling them it was two years and I haven't come back to court for my P.C.R application. My letter was return with a clerk of court stamp with a paper from Julie J Armstrong enclosed document returned saying I can't come back to court and I need Attorney General. That why I wrote Attorney General Eric H Holder and send him that paper. I file a civil suit against Evans Correctional Institution Dr. p Drage and medical staff. But they dismiss my complaint known my medical test show I need treatment. I wrote U.S District Court to the Magistrate judge Jaige J Gossett who was appointed to my case. I told her due to my medical issue it was behind my inefficient indictment. My letter was return to me saying I have to sign to enclosed document. I believe someone is using my signature acting like we marriage. Now I'm at Kershaw Correctional Institution and these people here doing the same thing. I truly believe of the people out Charleston Court room because they know I couldn't get sentence. It's someone working in Charleston clerk of court because when I file for my case history 2012-CP-100-2567 the day it was filed 4-19-2012 at 9:57AM, which was the incorrect information

to my post-conviction relief. Someone print out some paper and send it. The correct case history to my p.c.r. # 2012-CP-10-2567 filed 4-18-2012 at 4:47 pm. Now that how I know someone out Charleston Clerk of Court doing it. I wrote U.S. Marshal about beeing almost assassinate inside South Carolina department behind my indictment. I also wrote U.S. Department of Justice F.B.I. about the something. were on October 28, 2016 Jeffrey B. Veltri wrote back. While I'm at this Kershaw Institution I believe they working some where in here. They had one of these inmate steal my p.c.r. transcript and read it and a front page of a letter I wrote Attorney Katherine H. Hudgins and copy it. I really believe they trying to provoke me to hurt somebody or somebody wrt me behind insignificant indictment and information because they couldn't sentence me, and they don't want me to fight the case. I can see they doing whatever inside they power. who they can use to cover it all up. From their grandmother, mother mad cause I ain't liking none of their daughter and I ain't helping nobody out. So they manipulating Correctional officer and Inmate here telling them not to help me out because I don't have my information and I'm crazy. I believe my mother was killed behind my indictment and information cause I send her a copy in 2014. because I believe they don't want me to show the evidence of what they did. I believe they been using for something. that ^{why} it took so long for them to bring me back, Court.
