LEAVE TO PROCEED IN FORMA PAUPERIS

I, ROBERT WILLIAM WAZNEY, am in receipt of S.C. Court of Appeals paper dated December 12, 2018, which I received on December 19, 2018. Its December 12, 2018 paper requests deficiency correction for Motion consideration; I hereby state and reply with the following facts:

- 1.) This is an action regarding the appeal of 2016-CP-43-0733 Judgments dated July 14, 2018;
- 2.) I am the applicant in this action and I believe I am entitled to redress;
- 3.) Inappropriate government interference by the incursion of pretrial freezing of my untainted assets as a criminal defendant and where JAMES C. CAMPBELL CLERK OF COURT on many occasions denied my access to the Court by neglecting to present, as required by South Carolina law, in forma pauperis papers to the Court Judges so I may access those frozen assets has effected my poverty, consequently I am unable to pay for the costs of this proceeding or give security thereof;
- 4.) If in forma pauperis is denied, it operates to dismiss my appeal pursuant Rule 240(i) SCACR and which will conflict with decisions of the United States Supreme Court and bring more federal questions to this case pursuant 28 U.S.C. § 1331;
- 5.) This case is a delinquency action and "no court fee may be charged in delinquency and neglect actions" Ex Parte Martin, 321 S.C. 533, 471 S.E.2d 134 (1995);
- 6.) Court proceedings were had out of my presence where I needed to bring defences, and objections. "Where certain fundamental rights are involved, the constitution requires that an indigent be allowed access to the courts. Compare Boddie v. Connecticut, 91 S.Ct.780" Ex Parte Martin, 321 S.C. 533, 471 S.E.2d 134 (1995);
- 7.) This Court should approve in forma pauperis because I am unable to pay to bring action by reason of my indigency, Boddie v. Connecticut, 91 S.Ct. 780;
- 8.) Dismissal of this action by reason of my indengency violates or shall violate my First Amendment Constitutional rights guaranteed by the United States Constitution and South Carolina Consttution;
- 9.) I request this Court to provide relief as it deems fit and appropriate.

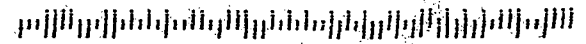
