ORDER

This appeal arises out of an order of a single commissioner denying the appellant's motion to reinstate at the Workers' Compensation Commission (the Commission). The single commissioner's decision does not appear to have been appealed to an appellate panel of the Commission. Accordingly, this appeal is dismissed due to the appellant's failure to exhaust all administrative remedies prior to seeking judicial review from this Court. *See* S.C. Code Ann. § 1-23-380 (Supp. 2018) ("A party who has exhausted all administrative remedies available within the agency and who is aggrieved by a final decision in a contested case is entitled to judicial review. . . ."); *Bone v. U.S. Food Service*, 404 S.C. 67, 84, 744 S.E.2d 552, 561 (2013) (finding the Administrative Procedures Act governs appeals in administrative cases). The remittitur will be sent as provided by Rule 221(b) of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules.
