
The reason for this request is that while working on the Return, I experienced a computer glitch which locked up the document so that it could not be edited. After about one hour, I was able to retrieve an earlier copy of the document and complete edits to the Return and prepare it for filing by mail. Upon arriving at the downtown Columbia post office at approximately 11.45 p.m. on the due date because of the computer delay, I discovered that the public access area of that branch was locked such that postage could not be purchased and the large parcel drop could not be used. This was contrary to all my previous experience using this branch for this purpose. I then proceeded several miles to the Northeast branch office on Two Notch Road. The service area of this branch was open, but the postage machine was inoperable for the purpose of weighing parcels and obtaining postage. I then proceeded a few miles further to the Clemson Road post office branch. The service area was open, the postage machine was operable, and I was able to purchase postage and mail the Return to the Court and to opposing counsel. By that time, however, it was approximately 12.40 a.m on January 3, 40 minutes past the current due date. The new, requested due date would be today, the date the packages were actually mailed out per SCACR 262.


