
ORDER

Some of the parties to this appeal have notified the Court that they have fully and finally settled their claims against one another. Accordingly, the notice of cross-appeal filed May 29, 2018, by Sea Island Food Group, LLC, d/b/a Squeeze (Sea Island) is dismissed. Additionally, Sea Island is named as a respondent in the notice of appeal filed May 15, 2018, by Yaschik Development Company, Inc., d/b/a Yaschik Enterprises (Yaschik). The effect of this order is a partial dismissal of the appeal and ends the claims between Sea Island and Yaschik as well as the claims between Sea Island and Michael J. Quillen Family Limited Partnership. The caption shall be amended as reflected above. The remaining parties to the appeal must use this caption on all future filings with the Court. The partial remittitur will be sent as provided by Rule 221(b) of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules.

Additionally, the Court received a second consent motion requesting that the filing deadlines for this appeal be held in abeyance. All parties have consented to the motion. Accordingly, the motion is Granted. The filing deadlines for this appeal shall be held in abeyance to allow the remaining parties to pursue mediation and possible settlement. Counsel must provide a written update no more than thirty days from the date of this order.
