PERSONALLY appeared before me, JoAnna Marsh, who being duly sworn, deposes and says:

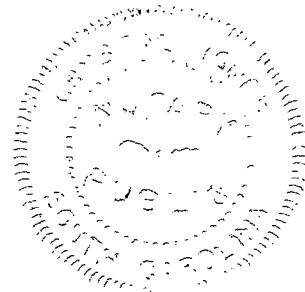
1. I am the petitioner in the above captioned case.
