Dear Mr. Jones:

Upon reviewing your corrected record on appeal and final brief of appellant, the following deficiency or deficiencies have been noted under the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR), and any deficiency must be corrected within ten (10) days of the date of this letter, or this appeal will be dismissed:

- The record on appeal is improperly paginated.
- The number of copies provided is not in compliance with the SCACR. You must provide an unbound original of the record on appeal, and final brief of appellant, along with fifteen (15) bound copies. If you wish to reduce the amount of bound copies, you must file a motion with the Court.
- The color of the cover of the final brief of appellant is not in compliance with Rule 267(e), SCACR. The cover of the final brief of appellant should be blue in color. If you cannot obtain blue covers, you must file a motion with the Court to be allowed to omit this requirement.
- The covers of the record on appeal, and final brief of appellant do not comply with Rule 267(e), SCACR. Specifically, opposing counsel is not listed on the cover of the record on appeal. The record on appeal should list the names of all parties/counsel for the appellant and the respondent. Also,

the captions of the record on appeal and final brief of appellant are not correct. The caption should read as follows:

The State, Respondent,

v.

Johnnie Lee Jones, Appellant.
