And for clarity the motion's were for insufficient evidence; my motion's should have been granted ~~and~~ being that the state failed to meet their burden of proof.

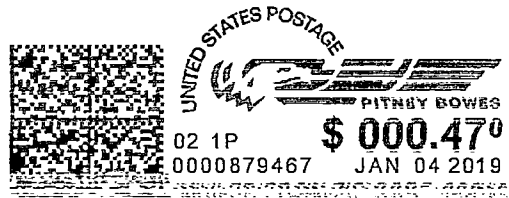
