



1) I would like to understand the costs and forms needed to order a transcript of Stritzinger v State of South Carolina from December 20th, 2019 at 2pm. I believe the total length of the hearing was about 15mins.

Mr. Parker appeared for the State of South Carolina, and I was self represented. Also noting Mr. Larry Smith the attorney assigned for Richland County did not appear as requested. I believe Judge Smiley signed the order appointing Mr. Parker as the States representative however I have not seen Mr. Parker's contract.

2) Also I need to request if your court intends to enter additional orders in this cause at some time in the future, or whether it is awaiting judge kelly's court to decide his motion for reconsideration which was paid for already? Ms. Henley from the court administrators office believed that this was in fact the case.

3) The Probate court has appointed Mr. Bart Bartlett to be my attorney in their court, and I would like the court to consider extending that to these proceedings which I believe I have already done most of the legal assistant work which he would not have to repeat.

4) Lastly, at this hearing I did not discuss the merits of my appeal from the South Carolina Probate Court (Smiley), nor the merits of my second appeal from South Carolina Probate Court (Belton) who has ordered me to stay in the State of South Carolina until trial in June which I believe is problematic for many reasons including the graduation of my son in his senior year in high school in Austin Texas.
