This office is in receipt of your appellant's initial brief and attachments.

You filed two notices of appeal in November, 2018. One notice of appeal referenced the order of the Administrative Law Court in 18-ALJ-04-0112-AP. The other referenced the order of the Administrative Law Court in 18-ALJ-04-0113-AP. On November 9, 2018, you were advised by letter that the appeals would be consolidated for consideration by the Court and all filings should be under Appellate Case Number 2018-001949.

Because of the consolidation, your appellant's initial brief should address the issues with respect to both 18-ALJ-04-0112-AP and 18-ALJ-04-0113-AP. From review of your appellant's initial brief, it appears that you only address the issues relating to 18-ALJ-04-0113-AP. This is the order that is cited on the title page of your brief.

Within twenty days from the date of this letter, you may serve and file an amended appellant's initial brief that addresses your arguments with respect to both

Administrative Law Court orders. You should also serve and file a Designation of Matter addressing both Administrative Law Court orders since only one record on appeal will be prepared under the consolidation.

The respondent will be advised of a date for service and filing of its respondent's initial brief and designation of matter once you have either filed your amended appellant's initial brief or the twenty day deadline has expired.
